COMMISSIONER TWINKLE CAVANAUGH TO VISIT LUVERNE

MONTGOMERY – Commissioner Twinkle Andress Cavanaugh will visit Hooks Bar-B-Que in Luverne, Alabama on Wednesday, March 30, 2011 at 3pm. She will be visiting Luverne as part of her Sixty-Seven County Tour.

Commissioner Cavanaugh is living up to her campaign promise to visit every County in Alabama each year she is in office. With this tour, she plans to educate constituents on issues involving the Alabama Public Service Commission, address their concerns, and listen to suggestions.

Commissioner Twinkle Andress Cavanaugh was elected to the Public Service Commission in November of 2010. She brings to the Commission an extensive career in public service.
