PSC SCHEDULES INFORMAL MEETINGS FOR MOBILE GAS

(MONTGOMERY) – At its December 2012 monthly meeting, the Alabama Public Service Commission (the “APSC”) voted unanimously to hold public proceedings to review certain aspects of Mobile Gas Service Corporation’s Rate Stabilization and Equalization (“RSE”) mechanism. In keeping with its commitment to conduct that review openly and transparently, the APSC has scheduled a series of public proceedings. As previously emphasized by the Commission in its unanimous vote, the participation of the public in those proceedings is invited and encouraged. Similar proceedings are envisioned for each of the utilities regulated by the APSC that operate under an RSE mechanism.

The first of the public proceedings regarding Mobile Gas is scheduled for January 30, 2013, at 10:00 a.m. at the RSA Union Building, 100 North Union Street (Carl L. Evans Chief Administrative Law Judge Hearing Complex – Room 900) in Montgomery, Alabama. Subsequent proceedings for Mobile Gas have also been scheduled for February 21 and March 13. The initial public proceeding will serve as a platform to establish the context and structure of the proceedings that will follow.
